ENHANCING EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE: LEARNING OUTCOMES WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS

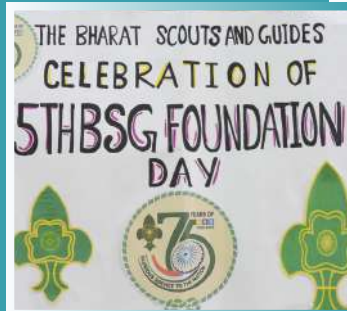
